
SUPERNATURAL JOY

God wants you to tap into His supernatural joy. His joy will sustain you, it will empower you through the challenges of life, and it will help you embrace change. Your joy level is not based on circumstances

- Receiving God's supernatural joy is one of the keys to full restoration - Ecclesiastes 5:18-20, Malachi 4:2
- Supernatural joy is a key to revival – Psalm 51:12-13
- Jesus told us to ask that our joy may be full – John 16:24
- Faith in God and His word brings joy – 1 John 1:4, John 15:11, Jeremiah 15:16

1. The oil of joy

Isaiah 61:1-5, Heb.1:9

There is an anointing for joy. Anointing with oil is an emblem of the Holy Spirit coming upon you, to empower you to be a King and a Priest. Being anointed is receiving a divine enablement. We are commanded to anoint with oil for healing and there is an anointing for supernatural joy (Mark 6:13, James 5:14-15).

2. In His presence is fulness of Joy

Psalm 16:11- You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is fullness of joy; at Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

Romans 14:17 - For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

3. Supernatural hope brings joy

*Romans 15:13 - Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace **in believing**, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.*

*1 Peter 1:8 - Whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, **yet believing**, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory.*

4. A merry heart is medicine

Proverbs 17:22 - A merry heart does good, like medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones.

5. God will bring laughter

Genesis 20:5-7, Psalm 126

6. We must choose to rejoice by faith

Nehemiah 8:9-12

Psalm 5:11-12 - But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield.

Philippians 4:4 - Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!
